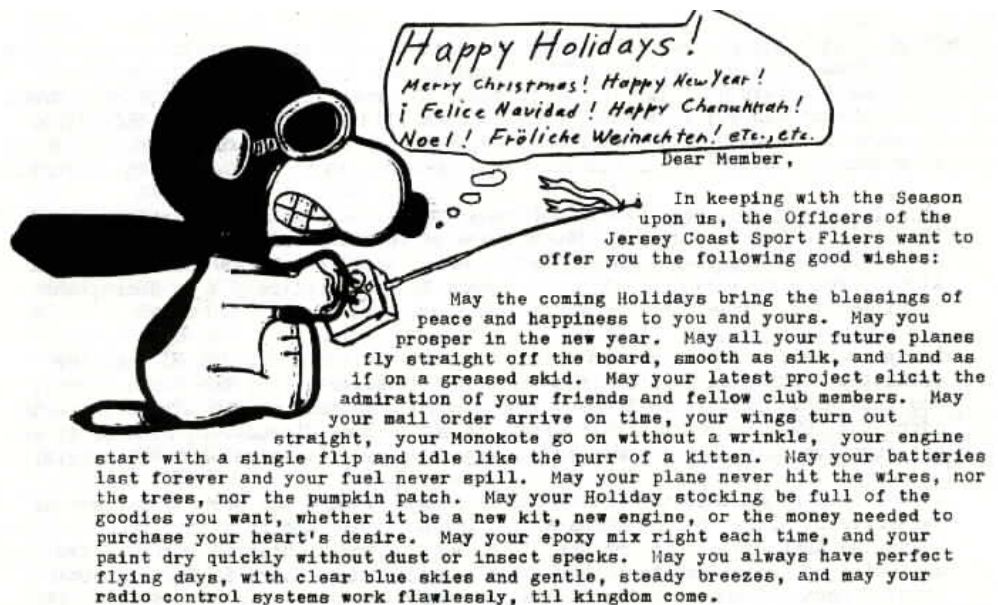
Hi,

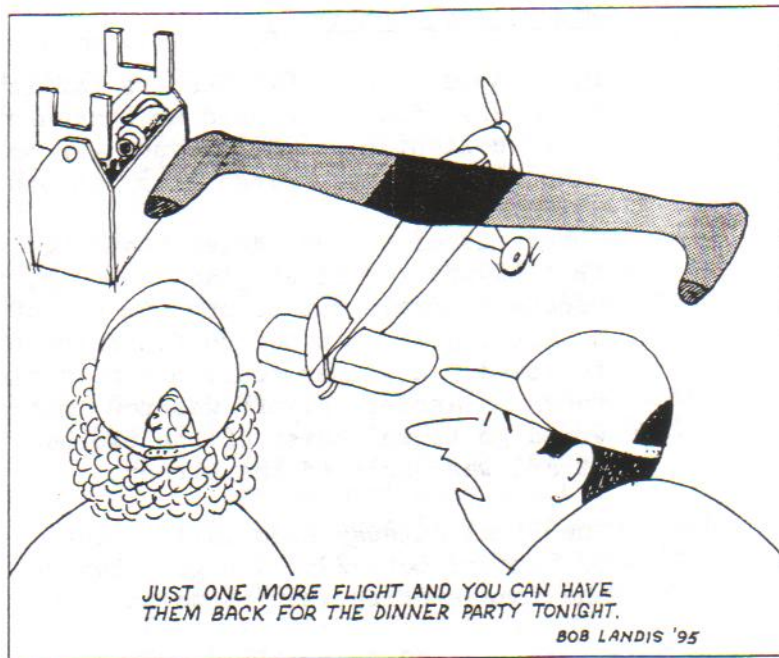

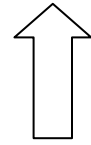
